

## Bio: Reginald Hageman

Reg Hageman lives in Helena, MT and graduated with a BA in Education, K-12 Physical Education and Health from Dickinson State University in 1998. Reg began teaching health and physical education that fall and has taught both middle and high school. Reg coached both high school football and track until 2010 when he decided to focus his time on raising his 3 children. Barrett is a Senior, Greta is a Junior, Shawn is a 6<sup>th</sup> grader. In 2013 Reg was elected to the SHAPE Montana Board and became the Advocacy Committee Chair, a roll in which he still currently serves. Reg was elected President-Elect in 2017 and again in 2020. In 2013 Reg attended his first SPEAK Out Day and has attended each year since. In 2014 Reg implemented an initiative called No Legislator Left Inside. SHAPE Montana members reached out to candidates for state and local offices to invite them to visit physical education classrooms, which was very well received. In 2017, Reg was awarded a sabbatical to implement the 150 Program in Montana. He and the Executive Director trained over 50 classroom teachers in Montana on Physical Education Standards and how to implement physical activity with their lessons in the classroom. Montana's Office of Public Instruction awarded SHAPE Montana \$20,000 to implement this pilot program. Each pilot school's goal was to attain 150 minutes of physical activity each week. Awards and accolades Reg has been recognized for include Distinguished Educator of the Helena Education Foundation in 2007, Health Hero for Eat Right Montana 2016, Dave Oberley Striving for Excellence by SHAPE Montana in 2021 and was the 2023 Montana High School Physical Education Teacher of the Year. Reg has learned so much from the amazing people that have become his friends in the professional community and hopes to continue to server teachers and students on the SHAPE America Board of Directors.
